This award recognises that the person is new in this particular role. Please be aware and enquire about what a person may have done in another company. If they have done this role in another company, they will not be eligible for the award.

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• **Equality, Diversity, and inclusion** (up to 150 words) Please tell us what your company has done, either in this production or beyond it to improve equality, diversity, or inclusion. Some examples might be to:

- *improve access for your audiences e.g., having a BSL interpreter.*
- Encouraging actors with learning disabilities to take part by offering them a mentor during rehearsals.
- Going out to new settings to encourage sign up by communities who are currently underrepresented in your company e.g., student freshers' fair or particular community groups.
